

# HOPE WATER AND LIGHT COMMISSION

## NET METERING TARIFF

### **AVAILABILITY:**

This schedule is available to any customer in all territory served by Hope Water and Light (HWL) who takes service under one of the following standard rate schedules; Residential Service, Small General Service, Large General Service, Light and Power, and Large Power, who has installed a net metering facility and signed a Standard Interconnection Agreement for Net-Metering Facilities with HWL. Such facilities must be located on the customer's premise and intended primarily to offset some or all of the customer's energy usage at that location. The generating capacity of net metering facilities may not exceed the greater of twenty-five kilowatts (25 kW) or one hundred percent (100%) of the net-metering customer's highest monthly usage in the previous twelve (12) months for residential use or three hundred kilowatts (300 kW) for any other use.

The Provisions of the customer's standard rate schedule are modified as specified herein.

### **MONTHLY BILLING:**

On a monthly basis, the net metering customer shall be billed charges applicable under the currently effective standard rate schedule and any appropriate rider schedules. Under net metering, only the kilowatt-hour (kWh) units of a customer's bill are affected.

If the electricity supplied by HWL exceeds the electricity generated by the net metering customer and fed back to HWL during the billing period, the net metering customer shall be billed for the net billable kWh's supplied by HWL in accordance with the rates and charges under the Company's standard rate schedule applicable to the customer.

If the electricity generated by the net metering customer and fed back to HWL during the billing period exceeds the electricity supplied by HWL, the net excess generation credit remaining in a net-metering customer's account at the close of a billing cycle shall not expire and shall be carried forward to subsequent billing cycles indefinitely. However, for net excess generation credits older than twenty-four (24) months, a net-metering customer may elect to have HWL purchase the net excess generation credits in the net-metering customer's account at the electric utility's estimated annual average avoided cost rate (this avoided cost to be calculated as the annual average of the purchase power cost plus the related transmission cost) for wholesale energy if the sum to be paid to the net-metering customer is at least one hundred dollars (\$100).

# HOPE WATER AND LIGHT COMMISSION

Any renewable energy credit created as the result of electricity supplied by a net metering customer is the property of the net metering customer that generated the renewable credit.
